MORE THAN 120 C8'S ARE HEADED TO THE CRUSHER



On December 11th, 2021, an EF3 tornado touched down and caused unimaginable devastation to the state of Kentucky. The tornado, which reportedly measured 3/4 of a mile across at its widest, traveled across some 220 miles of the state before it finally dissipated. In its wake, it left 76 people dead, countless more injured and caused approximately \$18 BILLION dollars worth of damage to homes, businesses, and cities across the Bluegrass state, with much of that damage in Mayfield and Bowling Green, Kentucky. TO BE CLEAR – the story that follows in this article is incidental compared to the devastation felt by so many. We also want to acknowledge everyone who has stepped up across the state to provide aid, shelter, or any other form of relief to the millions that were impacted by this horrible storm. We cannot wrap our heads around the loss that so many experienced, and we want to convey our most heartfelt regret for your loss.

The same tornado that ravaged so much of the state also came into direct contact with the Corvette Assembly Plant, the National Corvette Museum and the NCM Motorsports Park, all of which are located off of Route 65 at Exit 28 in [Bowling Green, Kentucky](#). As the people of Bowling Green began their recovery efforts in the hours, days, and weeks that followed this horrific storm, the extent of the damage became more commonly known. For its own part, the National Corvette Museum appeared to have sustained only minor damage, while the plant and the race track were impacted more severely. It was also reported that, as GM began clean-up of the Assembly Plant that an estimated 115-122 new Corvettes, many of which were still inside the plant at the time of the storm, were to be crushed due to damage each car sustained during the storm. Owners of each were contacted and were instructed that new orders would be put back into the Corvette plant's production cycle. Factory staff continue to inspect several of the completed cars at the time of this publication in an effort to ensure that each is okay to be delivered to its prospective future owner.



The decision was made to destroy these cars – rather than attempt to repair them – given the severity of the damage many of these cars encountered. The company’s concern was that these cars may have defects that would be undetectable until after they were turned out and released to the public. As a result, each of these cars was marked for destruction. The would-be owners of each were contacted and were instructed that new orders would be put back into the Corvette plant’s production cycle. Factory staff continue to inspect several of the completed cars at the time of this publication in an effort to ensure that each is okay to be delivered to its prospective future owner.

Of the cars that were adversely impacted by the storm, GM’s decision to destroy the cars was not an easy one. Production of the eighth generation Corvette has been impacted repeatedly since its introduction in 2020. Production was first delayed due to union disputes, then because of the original COVID surge in March 2020, then again in 2021 due to transmission and technology shortages, and now due to a natural disaster the likes of which has never before been experienced in the state of Kentucky.

“All customer vehicles coming off of the line after the downtime caused by December’s storm meet the high level of quality our customers expect,” a representative for Chevrolet stated on Thursday. “Vehicles and vehicle parts in the plant that were damaged by the storm are being scrapped and will not be used in production.”

“If a customer’s order was impacted by the storm, the customer will be contacted by their dealer and their order will be prioritized and re-sequenced back into production, with an expected production date as quickly as possible.”



2023 70TH ANNIVERSARY EDITION



You may have heard about the Chevrolet Corvette Z06 70th Anniversary Edition already. [It sort of leaked last week](#), and by *sort-of*, we mean Chevy inadvertently published photos and information regarding the anniversary model on its website. It wasn't up for very long, but it was long enough to let the cat out of the bag. However, it turns out the cat wasn't *completely* out of that bag.

Now, we do have full official information on the anniversary Corvette, and it's not just a Z06 thing. [Chevrolet](#) will offer the 70th Anniversary Edition package on the Z06 as well as Stingray models in 3LT trim. For Z06, the package is offered on 3LZ cars, meaning you won't ever find a base model 'Vette with the 70th Anniversary Package. You can have it with a coupe or convertible, but even if you don't check the box for the package, every single 2023 Corvette will have 70th Anniversary branding on the center speaker grille and rear window.

What makes this package special? Aside from badges, the 70th Anniversary Edition adds unique wheels with red edges and anniversary center caps. You'll also get red brake calipers, a rear bumper protector and trunk cover, and on 2023 Corvette Stingray coupes, the package adds a red engine cover. There's more red inside with contrast stitching and seatbelts, while the seats are a special Ceramic leather two-tone. Suede seat inserts and a suede steering wheel are included, and for travelers, there's a special set of anniversary-branded luggage.

What makes this package special? Aside from badges, the 70th Anniversary Edition adds unique wheels with red edges and anniversary center caps. You'll also get red brake calipers, a rear bumper protector and trunk cover, and on 2023 Corvette Stingray coupes, the package adds a red engine cover. 

The first production C8 Corvette Z06 slated for auction at Barrett-Jackson will be a 70th Anniversary Edition. As for the rest, they will go on sale later this year but you can let your imagination run wild right now with the [online Z06 visualizer](#), which has returned to Chevrolet's website.



CORVETTES CAN BRING BIG BUCKS



The most expensive Corvette ever sold at auction is the 1967 Chevy Corvette L88 Coupe, and it went for a whopping \$3.85 million at a collectible car auction in 2014 in Scottsdale. There were only 20 L88s in total that were built by Chevrolet and it's unknown just how many of them have survived through the years. This increases the value of those that resurface and make their way to auction. This L88 Coupe unseated the L88 Convertible model that had sold for \$3.4 million and took its place as the most expensive Corvette ever sold.



The second most [expensive Chevy Corvette ever sold at auction](#) is the 1967 L88 Convertible model. When it sold for \$3.4 million in September of 2013, it held the record for being the most expensive Corvette that had ever been sold, but it would only hold this title for a few months, because there was a yet more valuable member of the family that would soon make its appearance on the auction block. What makes this example so valuable is that only 20 of these fabulous editions were ever produced, add the fact that it's a convertible that was modified for track racing and you have a winning combination for increasing the worth. This specific car has won its share of races but was retired as a collector's car in the '70s.


